- Promote the positive aspects of cycling (e.g. fair play, health & well-being).
- Display consistently high standards of behaviour and appearance.
- Follow all guidelines laid down by Cycling Ulster, Cycling Ireland & ECC.
- Hold appropriate qualifications if acting in a coaching capacity.
- Never exert undue influence over performers to obtain personal benefit, reward or results.
- Never condone rule violations, cheating, or the use of prohibited substances.
- Encourage participation, not just results.
- Encourage & guide participants to accept responsibility for their own performance & behaviour.
- Ensure that all members, including newcomers are welcomed into the club and given appropriate advice.
- Be positive, approachable and offer praise to promote the objectives of the club at all times.
- Assist at marshalling and stewarding events organised by ECC
- Assist with the development of youth cycling within ECC
- Assist and support fundraising within the club
- Being separately (or jointly) involved in any one of more of the following activities shall be considered a serious breach: Bullying, sexual harassment, isolating, slandering, verbally abusing, assault or any form of discrimination towards any other club member.
